Essays on the Scottish Enlightenment

Professor Toshihiro Tanaka (Professor of History of Economics, Kwansai Gakuin University) has just edited a book of essays entitled *The Scottish Enlightenment and Economic Thought in the Making: Studies of Classical Political Economy I*, Nihon Keizai Hyoronsha, Tokyo, 1989, x, 285. It is written in Japanese with an English abstract at the end, and contains 10 essays—9 by Japanese scholars and one by Andrew Skinner. The topics include James Anderson, Adam Ferguson, David Hume, Frances Hutcheson, P. Lindsay, John Millar, Adam Smith, Sir James Steuart, and Dugald Stewart.

A second volume of essays on *The Formation and Development of Classical Political Economy*, also edited by Professor Tanaka, will be published in December 1989.
